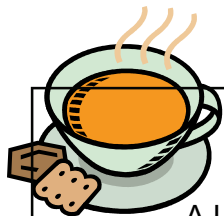

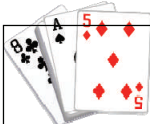

The Water Oak Staff and I wish all of you a healthy, prosperous and happy 2011!! May the New Year bring you everything you wish for and more. As always, if you have questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to call or stop in to complete a service request or ask the questions. All of us will be happy to assist you.

A few changes come along with the beginning of the New Year. Before you make out your check(s), please remember:

1. **Pass on payment on a monthly basis:** Pay the amount on the bill you got in the mail.
2. **Pass on payment in full:** Subtract the monthly amount (see your Rent Increase Notice) from the bill you got in the mail. Write a separate check for the total pass on amount and a check for the total of the water, mailbox and new rent amount and submit both checks.

Not sure of the amount or how you want to pay, just call or stop at the office. We will be happy to look it up for you.

A reminder: Just because someone advertises in the Water Oak Update newsletter, does not mean he is recommended or "checked out" by the office. We do not recommend contractors or services at any time. All contractors and services are your choice. It is always a good idea to check out a contractor's references through the State of Florida (DBPR), the Town of Lady Lake or the Better Business Bureau. Before signing a contract, ask for names and phone numbers of their last 3 jobs and then call to find out if the work was done properly, timely and within budget. If you want to know whether your contractor's paperwork is current and on file at the office, just call or stop in.

And last, never pay a contractor up front for anything and never pay until the work is completed in a workman like manner with all inspections signed off. A contractor should bring you the signed off permit(s) with their request for final payment.

RV Storage space is at a premium. As many of you know, the waiting list is long and spaces open up only infrequently. All spaces are awarded on a first come, first served basis, so if a space becomes available, it is offered to the person who has been on the list the longest, as long as the size of the space is appropriate for the RV.

Since these spaces are free and there are so few available, if you are privileged to have one, you are expected to keep it up at all times or you will be asked to forfeit the space. You will have no more than one week to remove the vehicle and clean up the space.

And finally, we continue Water Oak's "Yes, We Can!" campaign, collecting a bag, a box or a can of food at the Administrative Office during the beginning of each month. Your ongoing generosity supports the food banks and many needy families in the greater Lady Lake/Leesburg/Fruitland Park area. Water Oak's residents have been very generous with their monthly donations during the many years we have run this program and with your help we can continue our support in 2011!

The next Membership Meeting of the Water Oak Estate Homeowners' Association will be held on Thursday, January 27, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. in the Satellite Clubhouse.

On Thursday, February 24, 2011 the Annual Membership Meeting of the Water Oak Estate Homeowners' Association will be held at the Satellite Clubhouse. This meeting requires a quorum to conduct business, approve the 2011 Annual Budget and elect three new Association Directors. For this reason only members in good standing will be allowed to attend this meeting. If you even think that you will not be able to attend please submit the proxy ballot which you receive in your Annual Meeting Package which will be mailed to you prior to the meeting in accordance with our by-laws. At this meeting we will be electing three Directors. Although nominations can be submitted from the floor at the meeting, I would encourage anyone considering running for Director to submit their name to the Nominating Committee so that you may be included on the printed ballot. The Nominating Committee, headed by Mary La Noce, includes Gladys Hladik, Ann Floyd and Betty Bosch. They will be happy to take care of placing anyone interested in running on the ballot.

I have received several questions regarding the perceived high balance in our savings account. Since the Water Oak Estate Homeowners' Association was incorporated in 1986, through prudent fiscal policies the Homeowners' Boards of Directors have managed to build this fund in order to pay for legal advice, consultation and information. This is in accordance with Article 7.5 of our By-Laws (Reserve Fund). We budget for legal expenses in our annual budget and at the end of the year if there is a surplus it is placed in this Reserve Fund. The balance in the fund is a result of 24 years of savings. At current legal rates the fund represents approximately 230 hours of consultation OR 150 hours of litigation. The board feels that this is a prudent amount to hold in reserve and intends to preserve this Reserve Fund for the purpose as prescribed in the By-Laws.

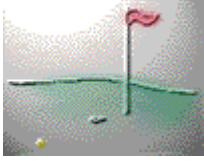
NEW YORK CLUB

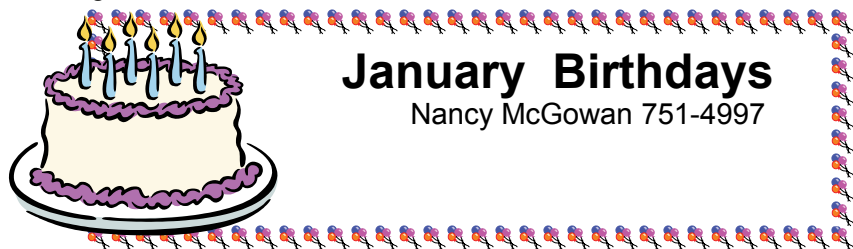
