## FROM THE MANAGER'S DESK Gabriele Umbel, Manager

Thank you for your patience during our recent paving and seal coating upgrades. Unfortunately, we had to close the outbound lane of Water Oak Boulevard several times to be able to seal coat properly. Those of you who live on Willow Way and Magnolia Drive and Spruce Drive were most affected, and I appreciate your patience while having to use the back gate to enter and exit the community.

**A request from the Lady Lake Animal Control Officer:** Please do not feed any wild life. Pet food that is left outside attracts all types of animals including squirrels, feral cats, opossums, raccoons, armadillos, skunks, and a variety of other animals you may not want around or under your home. Please keep all pet food inside your home in a locked container.

The recent warmer weather is helping the landscape grow again. Spend a little time outside and look around to see what can be saved and what needs to be replaced, removed or trimmed back. After the December and January freezes, most lawns look brown, but little green sprouts are starting to peek through. It's time to start dealing with the weeds that are always first to pop up. If you follow Tom McCubbin's column in the Orlando Sentinel, you have read that it's almost time to put down the first fertilizer of the year and also use pre-emergent weed preventer in the flower and shrub beds. Putting down something like Preen after weeding the beds first has saved many of us lots of extra work throughout the year.

While you're dealing with the landscape, take a walk around the back of your home as well. If your home has not been washed in the past 6 months, it's time to arrange for a house washing. Mold and mildew are not only unsightly but can also cause damage. Have the house washing company clean your gutters at the same time. Even without trees around your home, birds drop seeds that can start germinating in the gutters and cause clogs that can damage your home.

If you're planning your trip north already, remember to hire someone to maintain your home and homesite while you're gone. Weeding, fertilizing, trimming and edging need to continue while you're out of town. You may also want to ask the neighbors to keep an eye out that the work is actually getting done the way you are envisioning...a number of people find out via pictures and letters from the office that their yard person is not living up to his/her side of the bargain. As always, my recommendation is not to pay ahead but to pay for services rendered after they are done...

Have you had a chance to take a look at the new Skyline models during our Residents Only Open House? If not, please consider this another invitation to take a look. Even if you are not in the market to Trade In/Trade Up, Sun Homes is paying referral fees (\$1,000) to any resident who brings in a friend or relative that purchases one of our homes. Friends and relatives make wonderful neighbors, as many of you

already know.

And finally, the pink ring binders in both club-houses contain lists of residents with credits in their accounts. Take a look and see if you have a credit before writing the next rent check. Of course, you can also call the office or stop in and we'll be happy to assist you.

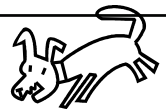

Our Flea Market will be over by the time you read this and hopefully we will have had as much success as we had last year. Last year we had to rent an extra table we had so much stuff.

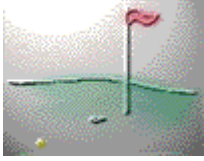
For March we are looking into the Silver Cricket Dinner Theater. It sounds like fun, so if you are interested, call me.
