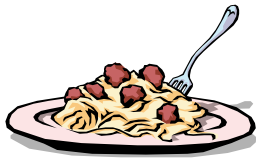

Judging from the feedback after the meeting, his presentation was interesting and informative, even though in parts it may have been a little technical. If anyone would like to check out any of the books he left, please stop by the office. Some of you got one at the meeting. When you are finished, please share your book with a neighbor or friend, or leave it in the library for someone else to take a look at it, too. We are trying to get additional copies from St. Johns River Water Management District to leave in the library.

Many of our seasonal residents left before Easter and quite a few are leaving by the middle of May. We will miss you all! Have a safe trip, enjoy your Northern family and friends, and we look forward to your return in the fall. Meanwhile, we'll work on improving the facilities some more while you are gone and don't have to put up with the "Under Construction" dust. The agenda includes a dishwasher for the Main Clubhouse, a refrigerator for the Satellite Clubhouse, chairs for the pool area as well as for the card room. We are also adding card tables for the bridge players, moving the Billiards room, adding electric circuits for the stage in the Satellite clubhouse and a variety of other things besides more new greens renovations on the golf course. A big THANK YOU! to everyone who responded to my letter about taking care of their yards. Much of the damage last winter inflicted has already been taken care of and quite a bit is still being done. 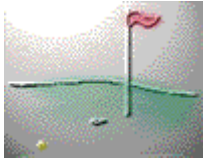
WATER OAK QUILTERS

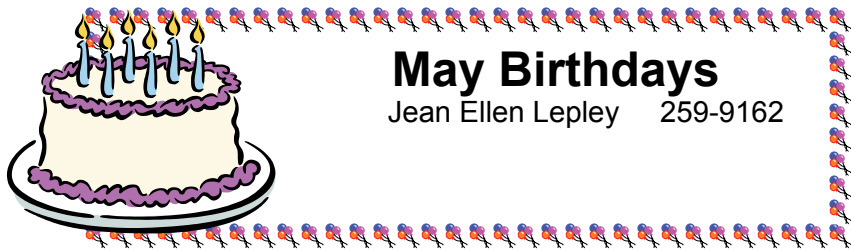
