The WOEHA Board has launched a treasure hunt for the next two months. Once an individual is elected to a directorship, the board itself reorganizes and selects the officers for the year. An elected director is voted to a term of three years. NO individual director acts on their own but as directed by the entire board. Each director is covered under a blanket organization liability.

Why do we need representative to association? Our responsibilities are to act on behalf of the park residents in all matters as related to Public Law 723. We review new rule proposals, rent tax and water increases and try to resolve disagreements between the park manager and members of the association. Using your expertise you can feel free to volunteer to oversee one of our standing Committees.

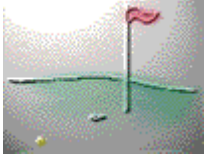
